THE MISSALS FROM OLOMOUC AND PRAGUE AND THE SERVICES
OF SS CYRIL AND METHODIUS

(Summary)

The article presents two short services of SS Cyril and Methodius still not scientifically discussed from two missals in the University Library at Bratislava – an incunabulum (Inc. 393) and an early printed book (22 B, 62902). The first one is the *Missale Olomucense* from 1499 and the other one is a new acquisition of the Library – *Missale Pragensis ecclesiae*, printed in 1507 in Venice. Both books contain in their calendars notes on the festival of the saints on March 9 and in the part of *Proprium sanctorum* formulars of their services, which are published now. On the basis of comparative analysis the author traces out the relationship between these texts and a Slavic short service of the two holy brothers, known from the archives of p. I. Martinov, S. J.
