THE SLAVONIC MANUSCRIPTS OF STAVROPOLEOS (BUCHAREST)

*(Summary)*

The article presents the collection of Slavonic manuscripts of Stavropoleos monastery (a former monastery in Bucharest which is now in the process of restoration of its status). The collection includes three manuscripts acquired after 1989.

The *first* of them, dated to the very end of the 15th century, is a liturgical codex including the ecclesiastical services for the major holidays. The *second* is an Old Believers' erotapocritical codex-convolute from the 18–9th century including texts with questions and answers on different theological topics mainly in the field of ecclesiology. The *third* is an Octoechos with musical notation from the 19th century.
